

PARTICIPATION TERMS

This section must be read and signed by you and your parent(s).

1. While in Canada, I am always under the jurisdiction of the national, provincial, and local laws. I will obey all laws. If I break the law (shoplifting, stealing, working, etc.) it will result in my termination, at my expense, from the program.
2. I will not consume alcohol or use illegal drugs while enrolled in the Newfoundland International Studies (NIS) program. Use of these substances will result in my termination, at my expense, from the program.
3. I will obey the rules of my homestay/custodian. This includes any curfew, chores and other rules they reasonably establish.
4. I will obey the rules of my school in Newfoundland. These rules include, but are not limited to, attendance and actively participating in classroom work. I agree to take part in extra-curricular activities.
5. I will not drive motorized vehicles except within the context of a formal driver's training program. Driver's training may be taken only with the written permission of my parents and I will allow NIS to hold my driver's license until I return to my home country.
6. Travel within Newfoundland - I understand that with the permission of my host family/custodian, I may travel throughout the province with them, a school student group, or other family.
7. Travel outside of Newfoundland - I understand that I require approval from NIS to travel outside the province with a group or my host family.
8. If I am participating in the Homestay Program, I understand that my program fees cover monthly charges for room, board, medical insurance and tuition.
9. If I am participating in the Homestay Program, I understand that visits by my family or friends from my home country are permitted no sooner than six weeks after my arrival in Newfoundland. If my family or friends visit, they are responsible to make arrangements for their lodging outside the home of the host family.
10. I understand that as a student in the NIS program, any report about my participation (marks, behaviour, etc.) may be sent to my parents and/or agent, if applicable.
Program Termination: I understand that NIS reserves the right to terminate participation for the violation of program rules and /or when my mental and/or physical health, as determined solely by NIS, are in jeopardy. If expelled from NIS, I will not be given a refund and I will be sent back to my home country at my own expense.
